Position in the Departments of Biology and Biochemistry of Bishop's University.

The Departments of Biology and Biochemistry of Bishop's University invite applications for a full-time **tenure-track faculty position in Plant Biochemistry**, beginning July 1, 2022. We are seeking applicants with expertise in plant biochemistry, plant physiology and bioinformatics. The successful candidate will be expected to teach between 3-5 courses per year depending on external funding and should be able to teach a first-year course in Molecular and Cellular Biology, an intermediate course in Plant Biochemistry/Physiology, and their choice of courses in either General Biochemistry, Bioinformatics, or a subject of their choice. Candidates must possess a PhD, an active research program and a competitive publication record. Bishop's University is primarily an undergraduate institution and candidates should have demonstrated compelling teaching ability at the undergraduate level, as well as the ability to offer research opportunities and experience to our honours students. Available research and teaching spaces include modern laboratories, a newly renovated greenhouse, and an outdoor garden area. Possibilities of collaboration with the newly created sustainable agriculture farm and program are also available.
